The Watershed Academy, in cooperation with Western Pennsylvania Conservancy, is pleased to announce a free, one-day workshop that will introduce you to the new **Watershed Stewardship Guide**. This training is intended for watershed managers, watershed specialists, municipal officials, planners, and watershed organizations.

The Watershed Stewardship Guide focuses on six components:

Watershed Organization Development and Sustainability

How to identify key players in your community and forge a cooperative and collaborative relationship to work toward common goals that ultimately benefit your watershed; also addresses the bottom line on how to maintain your organization.

Watershed Assessments

Getting acquainted with and discovering what is going on in your watershed in terms of water quality and water quantity and the environment within its boundaries.

Implementation

How to systematically carry out prioritized projects using financial and human resources efficiently.

Securing Financial & Human Resources

How to identify and locate financial and human resources (private and government) to develop and implement your watershed management plan.

Developing the Watershed Management Plan

How to develop a detailed vision and strategy that identifies specific actions to restore, maintain, enhance, and protect your watershed.

Monitoring for Success

How to measure your success against established goals to evaluate and quantify progress at regular intervals in the continuing implementation of your watershed management plan.

In addition to the one-day workshop, the National Park Service Rivers and Trails Program will provide follow-up mentoring services to watershed organizations that attend.

DIRECTIONS

To the Genetti Hotel in Williamsport:

From Route 15 South: Hepburn Street, Lewisburg Exit. Take "Business District". At the first traffic light, make a left onto William Street; go two blocks.

From Route 15 North: Follow signs to Williamsport "Business District," go two traffic lights; make a left onto Fourth Street. Go two more traffic lights; make a right onto William Street.

From East I-80: Take Exit 26, Route 220 North to Williamsport. Follow signs to Route 15, Hepburn Street, Lewisburg Exit. Take "Business District" at first traffic light. Make a left onto William Street, go two blocks.

From West I-80: Go to 180 West Exit. Take Route 15 South to Basin Street Exit. After exiting road, continue straight to the fourth traffic light. Turn right onto William Street and go two blocks.

PARKING IS LOCATED DIRECTLY BEHIND THE HOTEL.

To the PA Fish and Boat Commission in Harrisburg:

From Route 81 South: Take Exit 69, Progress Avenue. Bear right at traffic light onto Progress Avenue. Go approximately .5 miles to the traffic light at the intersection of Progress and Elmerton Avenue; bear right onto Elmerton Avenue. Go approximately 1 mile to the intersection of Elmerton and State Farm Drive; turn left onto State Farm Drive. The entrance to the PFBC is approximately 100 yards on the left.

From Route 81 North: Take Exit 67a, 22 and 230 East-Cameron Street. The exit merges onto Cameron Street. Go approximately .3 miles on Cameron Street to the first traffic light, which is the intersection of Cameron and Elmerton Avenue; turn left onto Elmerton. Go approximately 1 mile on Elmerton to the intersection of Elmerton and State Farm Drive; turn right onto State Farm Drive. The entrance to the PFBC is approximately 100 yards on the left.

From PA Turnpike East, Route 76: Take Exit 226, Carlisle-Route 81. Follow signs to 81 North; get on 81 North. Follow instructions above, for Route 81 North.

From PA Turnpike West, Route 76: Take Ext 247, Harrisburg East-Route 283. Follow signs to 283 North and 83 North; get on 81 North. Follow instructions below, for Route 83 North.

From Route 83 North: Continue on 83 North to the junction with Route 81; bear left onto 81 South. Follow instructions above, for Route 81 South.

From Route 322 East: Continue on 322 until it becomes 22 and 230 East into Harrisburg; you are now on Cameron Street. Go to the first traffic light after crossing over Route 81, this is the intersection of Cameron and Elmerton Avenue; turn left onto Elmerton. Go approximately 1 mile on Elmerton to the intersection of Elmerton and State Farm Drive; turn right onto State Farm Drive. The entrance to the PFBC is approximately 100 yards on the left.
